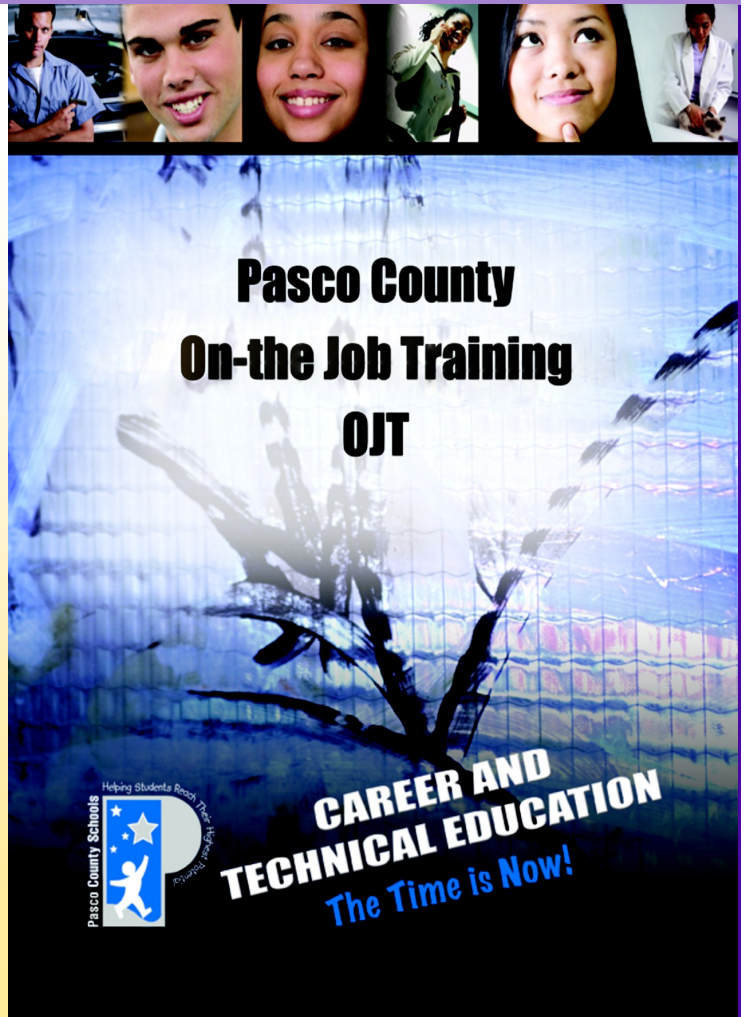
BCE-OJT
